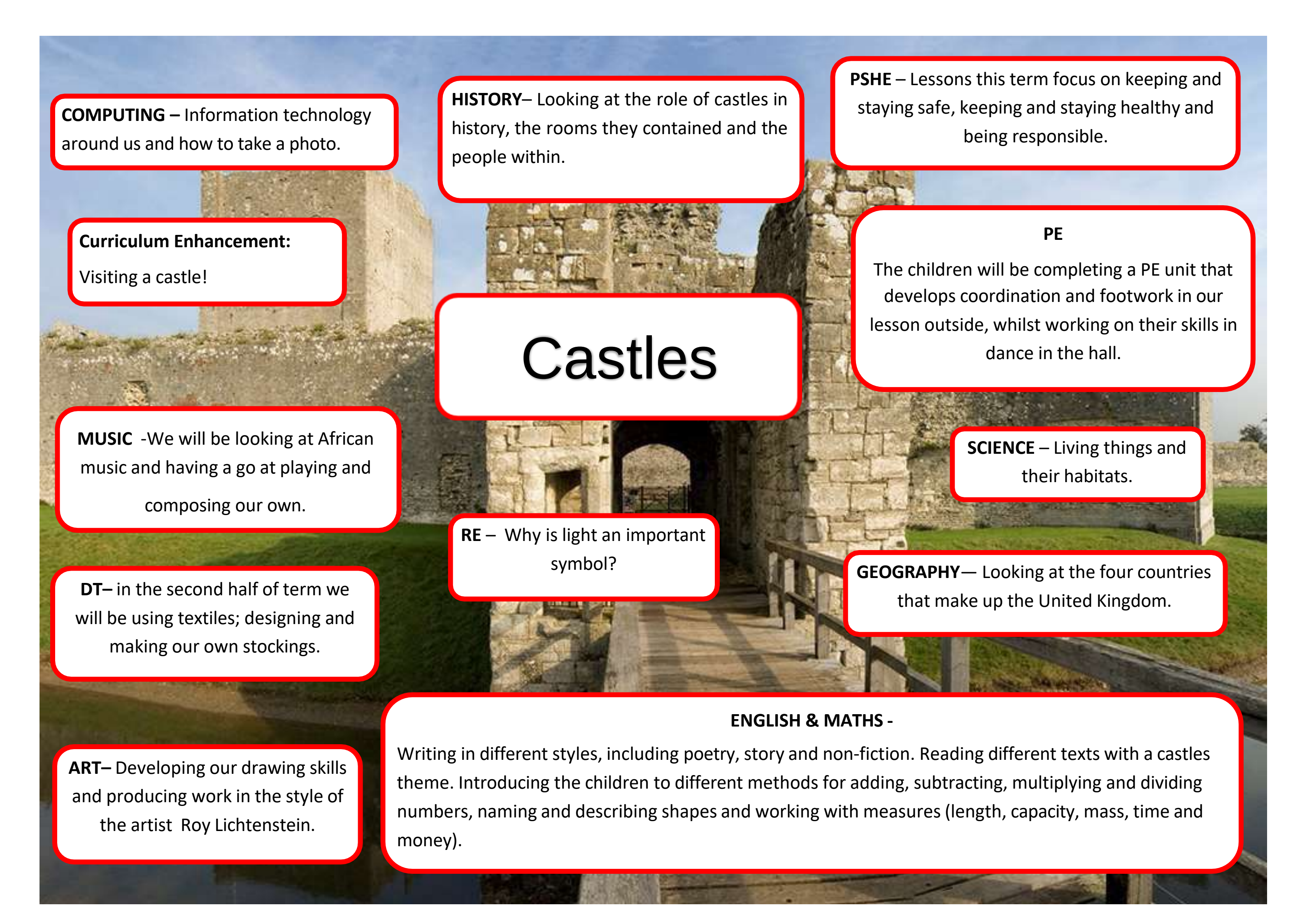




COMPUTING – Information technology around us and how to take a photo.
