NHS advice for Glandular Fever is that children can still come into school if they are physically able to concentrate. Children suffering with Scarlet Fever can return to school within 24hrs after starting appropriate antibiotic treatment.


Head Lice

Please could we remind all parents to check their children's hair regularly, by thoroughly combing through the damp hair from the roots with a fine toothed comb, or a headlice detector comb (available from the local chemist) over a pale sheet of paper or a towel. If your child has long hair, please ensure this is always tied back for school. If live lice are found, please treat before sending your child back to school.
